**Policy Statement of the Association  
concerning  
1<sup>st</sup> Vice President (Baseball) Duties**

The Constitution of the Peninsula Umpires Association defines the duties and responsibilities of its elected and appointed officers. The duties and responsibilities of the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President are for the Association's "Baseball Program", as outlined in the Association Policies and Procedures. To further clarify the Association's expected performance level of the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, the following will be understood to be inclusive with the execution of those duties and responsibilities:

1. The 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President will cause to be executed all evaluations of umpires assigned to the Baseball program of the Association.
2. The 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President will select and appoint Journeyman (CC) and/or Collegiate (D1) classified umpires to serve as "Mentors" for all Association members that are classified at the "Apprentice" and "Certified Apprentice" level.
3. Association members classified at levels other than "Apprentice" and "Certified Apprentice" may be assigned a mentor as association's membership permits. Emphasis will be given to the new members and lower classification level umpires.
