**Policy Statement of the Association
concerning
Association Evaluation Program**

The Policies and Procedures of the Peninsula Umpires Association define the Evaluations Program of the Association. To further clarify the Association's intent of the Evaluations Program, the following will be understood to be inclusive with the conduct of the Evaluations Program:

1. The Associations Evaluation Officer will select and appoint Journeyman (CC) and Collegiate (D1) classified umpires to perform the evaluations.
2. The Evaluation Officer will plan and conduct special training sessions for the appointed evaluators prior to the beginning of a season, as necessary.
3. The Association's membership will make arrangements through the Evaluations Officer for evaluations that those members may desire.
4. The evaluator's fee will be the mean of the 18U (Baseball and Softball) and 10U (Baseball and Softball). This fee will be held from a members earnings at the end of a season and remitted to the evaluators the have performed evaluations for that member during the season. For the 2005 season, this fee will be = \$26.00.
5. For any additional evaluations requested beyond the limit of two per season, the umpire desiring the evaluation will forfeit the game fee for that game he/she is working to the evaluator. There will be no travel fees remitted to the evaluator, that fee will be remitted to the umpire working the game.
