Policy Statement of the Association concerning Evaluation Officer Duties

The Constitution of the Peninsula Umpires Association defines the duties and responsibilities of its elected and appointed officers. The duties and responsibilities of the Evaluations Officer are for the Association's "Evaluation Program", as outlined in the Association Policies and Procedures. To further clarify the Association's expected performance level of the Evaluations Officer, the following will be understood to be inclusive with the execution of those duties and responsibilities:

1. The Evaluations Officer will cause to be executed all evaluations of umpires assigned to the Baseball/Softball programs of the Association.
2. The Evaluations Officer will select and appoint Journeyman (CC) and Collegiate (D1) classified umpires to serve as evaluators.
3. The Evaluations Officer will plan and conduct special training for all selected and appointed evaluators prior to the beginning of a season, as needed.
